Singapore, October 16, 2000 – Sunright Limited (“Sunright”) announced record turnover of S\$ 185 million for the financial year ended July 2000 jumping 48 percent from S\$ 125 million in the same period last year. This result was better than the actual semiconductor industry growth for 1999 and forecast for year 2000.

Its net earning was also up 48 percent from S\$ 2.1 million to S\$ 3.1 million. Earnings per share climbed to 2.5 cents from 1.7 cents.

According to Dataquest, the semiconductor industry achieved 22 percent growth in 1999. For year 2000, Dataquest expects the chip market to grow from US\$ 169 billion to US\$ 231 billion or 37 percent.

Given the high growing demand for semiconductors as well as the explosive growth fueled by the Internet and wireless applications which have driven demand for many different types of new chips, we see a fast growing market for test services”, said Mr. Sam Lim, Executive Chairman & Chief Executive Officer of Sunright.

He added, “despite the volatility of the semiconductor industry, Sunright has always been profitable. Our Test segment has recovered and expects to become more profitable. By expanding our customer base, Sunright has taken steps to capture the increasing volumes of test business”.

Mr. Lim declared, “test will lead the growth for this financial year”.
