Sunright Reports Continued Profitability

Singapore, September 23 2011: - Singapore based Sunright Limited (SGX: Sunright) today announced results for financial year ended 31 July 2011.

Mr. Sam Lim, Executive Chairman & Chief Executive Officer said, "Sunright has achieved another profitable year, with a net profit of S\$4.7 million. All business segments were substantially on track, making good growth, in line with opportunities in the automotive, personal computer ("PC") and communication markets."

This year's net profit was, however, lower than the S\$6.2 million in the previous year. Turnover had declined by 6 percent from S\$124.2 million to S\$116.3 million. Market sentiments were dampened by a stagnant U.S. economy and the European sovereign debt crises. This was further aggravated by the earthquakes and tsunami in Japan, which dented worldwide automotive sales. The headwinds also impacted PC demand.

These disruptions caused major customers to tighten their purse strings and defer capital purchases, which has resulted in lower sales for our products.

He concluded, "The global macroeconomic outlook is now cloudy. Nevertheless, our customers are market leaders who continue to develop new devices. These innovative chips are encouraging signs for Sunright and we look forward to benefiting when their production expands."
